2. Student’s age
3. Student’s level (see below)
4. Note if the entry is a Solo, Duet, or Trio
5. Name of the composition
6. Composer
7. Playing time
8. Student’s scheduling preference (AM or PM, or ANY)
9. Absolute conflicts, duet partners, or additional comments
